Vendor Essentials

- Our market thrives on the fact that we are a genuine DESTASH event. This means that we are selling excess products at discounted prices. This makes us unique and successful - meeting our customers' expectations.
- Allowed products include -: quilting fabric, dress fabric, vintage fabric, notions, haberdashery, craft items, threads, sewing books, hand stitching items, embroidery, sewing gadgets, sewing and crafting tools, patterns and craft magazines.
- Handmade clearance items and excess small business stock is welcome but must only take up a small part of your offer.
- We do not accept-: non handmade clothing, items that are not sewing or craft related, plants, candles, general handmade. If you have items to sell and are unsure please touch base before applying through our website
- All sites will need their own tables and equipment. If you are outside you will need a marquee and marquee weights. Tables can be hired.
- We have a Vendors Facebook page as well as a Stallholder Update which is emailed out to help you with planning for the event. Liking, sharing and commenting from stallholders is essential.

Public Liability

- Public Liability Insurance is vital for all stallholders. Then you will need to provide your policy info in the Application.
- Together Event Co has it's own market insurance but all vendors require their own in the case of any issues caused to the public.
- As the event co-ordinator we can provide your public liability insurance at the discounted rate of \$20 for table market sites and \$30 for all 3m x 3m or larger site. Please indicate this on your application submission.
- Our Market Insurance now only provide us with a limited number of additional add ons. If you are doing multiple events a year please look at taking out your own policy. mymarketinsurance.com.au

Market Entry

- Early Bird Entry to the event is \$5 - these tickets will give customers the first access to the market from about 8.45am.
- Entry from 10am will be \$2.
- 12noon to 2pm noon will be FREE and under 15 are free.
- We will again allocate close disabled parking but we cannot man and control the area. There is free parking, which is plentiful at the Mt Gravatt Showgrounds
- No pets allowed without a permit

Markdown Madness

From 12noon till 2pm entry to the event will be FREE. 12noon is the time to discount, haggle, spruik and reduce your stock! Prepared your signs - sell off your remaining stock and if you don't want to take it home consider speaking with the onsite charity sewing groups to donate.

We will be doing a huge push on this in June and adding it to our marketing plan.

Our Advertising

Our investment in advertising ensures our success! We invest in a strong marketing campaign to reach our audience and bring numbers to the event.

We work with an amazing local small business to make things happen and to ensure that the right people see and attend. We promote the market as a joint venture - on occasion we will use vendor photos but the market group advertising is our goal.

Our advertising is targeted on FB and IG - it is designed to reach our target market.

Event Sites

The event will be held in the Hamill Harris Hall, Goss Green and now also in the Memorial Hall at the Mt Gravatt Showgrounds - there is both inside and outside stall locations. All sites will need their own tables, equipment, marquee if outside and marquee weights. Table Hire is \$15 but we encourage you to bring your own. Stall options are:

Inside Table Site Hamill Harris Hall \$60 (fee includes 2.1m table)

Inside 3m x 3m Site Hamill Harris Hall \$120 (will accommodate 3 to 4 tables)

Inside 3m x 6m Site Hamill Harris Hall \$240 (will accommodate 7 to 8 tables)

Annex Table Site Hamill Harris Hall \$50 (will accommodate a single table only)

Outside Table Site Goss Green \$60 (shared Marquee 1.8m x .7m table only)

Outside 3m x 3m Site Goss Green \$100 (will accommodate 3 to 4 tables)

Outside 3m x 6m Site Goss Green \$200 (will accommodate 7 to 8 tables)

NEW Inside Table Site Memorial Hall \$60 (includes 1.8mx .7m table)

NEW Inside 3m x 3m Site Memorial Hall \$120 (will accommodate 3 to 4 tables)

NEW Inside 3m x 6m Site Memorial Hall \$240 (will accommodate 7 to 8 tables)

NEW Under Veranda Table Site Memorial Hall \$60 (includes 1.8m table)

PLEASE NOTE: All sites typically butt up to each other – we ask that you kindly stay within your allocated site as we prefer not to bring out the measuring tape

Goss Green sites will be extended this year to cover around and incorporate the sides of the Memorial Hall.
